



Environmental Policy

The Kitigan Zibi Anishinabeg (KZA) Band offers silviculture services on public land. As part of its commitment to protecting the environment and ensure sustainable management of the forest resources, Kitigan Zibi adopted and implemented a comprehensive package of environmental practices for its non-commercial silviculture activities on public land (except for activities on TPI and administration buildings). This commitment will allow the workers and the KZA community members to benefit from a healthy environment and ensuring future opportunities of development on its traditional territory.

The implementation of an ISO 14001: 2015 environmental management system (EMS) will help frame the commitments, objectives, targets, procedures and monitoring carried out daily and ensure that efforts provide concrete and measurable results.

To minimize environmental impacts concerning our activities, we commit to:

- Comply with applicable legal requirements and other requirements to which KZA subscribes which relate to its environmental aspects. If necessary, go beyond these standards to ensure the maintenance of ecosystems and biodiversity of the forests.
- Prevent pollution, reduce waste and minimise the use of resources.
- Continual improvement of environmental performance

This Policy will be communicated to all staff, contractors and suppliers, and be available to the public.
