### Kitigan Zibi Anishinabeg Post Secondary Scholarship Fund Program

Under this **NEW** Program, eight (8) \$2500 scholarships will be awarded to successful college/university students attending publically recognized accredited post secondary institutions in Canada. Financial support for the program is funded through a donation from the Peace Hills Trust Bank.

There will be one scholarship awarded per student studying in the designated fields in both the college and university levels for a total amount of \$20,000!

The applicant must also be an approved recipient for post secondary funding under the Kitigan Zibi – Post Secondary Student Support Program.

#### **Scholarship Description**

The Kitigan Zibi Anishinabeg Post Secondary Scholarship Fund supports and acknowledges deserving students who are studying in fields related to the 5 different categories you may apply for if your program qualifies:

**HERE ARE THE 5 CATEGORIES OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS** (with examples of Programs that qualify):

- FINANCE: Certified Public Accountant CPA, Bookkeeping, Business Finance, Commerce, etc.
- NURSING: Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Science in Nursing, etc.
- **EDUCATION:** Child Studies, Early Childhood Education, Bachelor of Education, etc.
- SOCIAL WORK: Bachelor of Social Work, Psychology Programs, Mental Health and Substance Abuse, etc.
- **ENVIRONMENTAL:** Environmental Technician, Environmental Science, Forestry, Ecology, etc.

Applicants for the Kitigan Zibi Post Secondary Scholarship must be a student in good standing at any of the "Recognized Institutions" outlined by ISC in relation to the KZES Post Secondary Program operating local policies.

The institution must be a publically recognized and accredited college or university and the recipient in good standing with the KZES Post Secondary Student Support Program at the time of application and at the time of award.

- 1. Must have successfully completed, or will complete by the award date, at least two semesters of post secondary study and must be a full-time student enrolled and in process of completing a full time FINANCE program.
  - Amount awarded to a college level student: \$2,500
  - Amount awarded to a university level student: \$2,500
- 2. Must have successfully completed, or will complete by the award date, at least two semesters of post secondary study and must be a full-time student enrolled and in process of completing a full time NURSING program.
  - Amount awarded to a college level student: \$2,500
  - Amount awarded to a university level student: \$2,500
- 3. Must have successfully completed, or will complete by the award date, at least two semesters of post secondary study and must be a full-time student enrolled and in process of completing a full time EDUCATION program.
  - Amount awarded to a college level student: \$2,500
  - Amount awarded to a university level student: \$2,500
- 4. Must have successfully completed, or will complete by the award date, at least two semesters of post secondary study and must be a full-time student enrolled and in process of completing a full time ENVIRONMENTAL program.
  - Amount awarded to a college OR university level student: \$2,500
- 5. Must have successfully completed, or will complete by the award date, at least two semesters of post secondary study and must be a full-time student enrolled and in process of completing a full time SOCIAL WORK program.
  - Amount awarded to a college OR university level student: \$2,500

The scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of academic performance, A/R's if and any in owing, Academic Probation and financial need (Other funding sources will be included with this application).

Past scholarship recipients are allowed to reapply.

#### **Program Guidelines & Priorities:**

• Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college <u>or</u> three-four (3-4) year college or university.

- Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of September 2022 directly to the student upon verification of their post secondary status and fulfillment of the Post Secondary Program Guidelines & Priorities.
